Page 276, line 16

For: Gardasil has been approved for use by girls and women aged 9 to 26 of age but for the vaccine to be effective, they need to be vaccinated before becoming sexually active.

Read: Gardasil has been approved for use by girls and women aged 9 to 26 years of age. To maximize the benefits of the vaccine, routine vaccination of all girls should be undertaken before they become sexually active, i.e., at 10-12 years of age.
